## Camp Regulations

1. As a camper, you are expected to attend all our activities and to keep the staff informed about where you are at all times.
2. We appreciate the relationship between staff and campers to be as friendly as possible, however as a camper, it is important that you respect the leaders and are willing to follow their guidelines.
3. During the camp you will be asked to contribute to living in community by helping with house duties and being part of a kitchen duty and washing-up rota.
4. English is the official language of our camp and campers are required to respect this at all times. There cannot be any excluding of people who speak a different language or forming of "cultural groups" in general.
5. It is not allowed to start any romantic relationship during the camp. Campers of the opposite gender are not allowed to enter each other's rooms or to isolate themselves in secluded places.
6. The possession or consumption of alcohol, cigarettes or any form of drugs is not allowed.
7. The IBTI is not liable for any stolen personal items which were left unattended.
